PCVE TRAINING

Course for Understanding Radicalization into Violent Extremism (CURVE) is a Training of Trainers (ToT) that endeavors to provide participants with skills in preventing and countering violent extremism. The course comprises of ten modules and runs for two weeks, covering a range of topics.

Objectives

The objectives of the Course are:

- To create a pool of trainers with a deep, wide and comprehensive grasp and understanding of Preventing and Countering Violent Extremism (PCVE).
- 2. To impart PCVE pedagogical skills to the course participants.
- 3. To expose the course participants to Islamic institutions and Muslim places of worship (especially Mosques and Madrassas) for familiarization and interaction with Muslim religious leaders.
- 4. To learn PCVE best practices from other parts of the world.

Expected Outcomes

By the end of the course the participants should be able to:

- 1. Analyze typology of terrorism.
- 2. Discuss role of religion in violent extremism.
- 3. Elaborate on the drivers of radicalization into violent extremism.
- 4. Identify early warning signs of a radicalized youth and a radicalizer.
- 5. Discuss effective messaging in PCVE.
- 6. Explain the role of duty bearers in PCVE.

- 7. Discuss preventive strategies to radicalization into violent extremism.
- 8. Develop PVE and CVE Action Plan.
- 9. Outline the historical development of violent extremism in the Horn of Africa region.
- 10. To organize a PCVE training pedagogy and programming.

Important Information:

- The minimum number of people to be trained is 20 and a maximum of 25 people.
- 2. Participants will organize for their transport and accommodation.
- In the event that the facilitators travel, then the costs of transport and accommodation will be borne by the client.
- Charges are exclusive of transport and accommodation.
