INVOLVE PCVE TRAINING

Identification that Navigates Vulnerabilities and Objectively Limiting Violent Extremism (INVOLVE) is a '...PCVE course for beginners that provides participants with skills in preventing and countering violent extremism. The course runs for one week and covers a range of topics categorized in five modules. The course facilitators are experienced experts and trainers in the field of PCVE in the Horn of Africa region. The training will, in a conflict-sensitive way, help trainees address, fight and eliminate, or reduce the vice without making those efforts counterproductive.

The training applies highly participatory methods which incorporates slides, stories, testimonies, games, gallery walk, and group work.

Objectives

The objectives of the course are:

1. To acquaint the participants with terminologies used by violent extremists.
2. To understand the changing drivers of radicalization into violent extremism.
3. To learn the early warning signs of radicalization into violent extremism
4. To understand prevention strategies of terrorism, radicalization, extremism, and violent extremism.
5. To expose the course participants to Islamic institutions and Muslim places of worship (especially Mosques and Madrassas) for familiarization and interaction with Muslim religious leaders.
6. To learn PCVE best practices from other parts of the world.

Expected Outcomes

By the end of the course, the course participants should be able to:

1. Define concepts related to Violent and Counter Violent Extremism.
2. Analyze typology of terrorism.
3. Discuss role of religion in violent extremism.
4. Describe the process of radicalization.
5. Elaborate on the drivers of radicalization into violent extremism.
6. Identify early warning signs of a radicalized youth and a radicalizer.
7. Explain the process of de-radicalization.
8. Discuss effective messaging in PCVE.


Important Information:

1. The minimum number of participants to be trained is 20 and a maximum of 25.
2. Participants will be required to cater for their transport and accommodation.
3. In the event that the facilitators have to travel to where the course participants are, then the cost of transport and accommodation will be borne by the client.
